Health and Safety Policy:

It is our intent to demonstrate an ongoing and determined commitment to improving health and safety at work throughout our organization.

The Consortium aims to make all necessary efforts to protect its employees and other persons which may be affected by its activities from work related injuries and illnesses, avoid damage to its and third party property and to eliminate negative impacts to the environment.

We will comply with the requirements of health and safety legislation and of our Clients health & safety standards and promote Industry best practice. Adequate resources will be provided to ensure all our employees, sub-contractors and stakeholders are aware of this policy and committed to its effective implementation.

- All incidents can be prevented.

Roles and responsibilities for health and safety will be defined, as necessary, within job descriptions or profiles. Our company top management will ensure that:

- Senior management will demonstrate leadership in health and safety.

- Our risks are adequately assessed, controlled and monitored.
- Our employees and sub-contractors have the competence to conduct their duties safely.
- Our employees are actively involved in matters that affect health & safety.

Systems will be in place and our employees, sub-contractors and stakeholders will be empowered to raise health and safety concerns with management.

We will take action to prevent, reduce or control risks to a tolerable level and reduce the potential for incidents to People, Environment and Property.

We will report and investigate incidents and near misses to drive improvement in our health and safety management. Any lessons learned from such events will be used to take corrective action to prevent recurrences and promote opportunities for continual improvement.

We will actively and openly, review and report on our health and safety performance against our objectives and targets. Improvement plans will be developed to support the delivery of such objectives and targets.

We will implement management systems to ensure we comply with health and safety legislation; fulfill the requirements of our clients and to continually strive to improve our health and safety performance.
